Meeting called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

OLD BUSINESS

BUILDING ENCLOSURE UPDATE – Project is now complete with just some touch up needed on the exterior siding and the inside should be stained/sealed next spring. Approximate cost of this project was \$17,900.00. We may need to install a “sound cloud” like we have in the main building to assist with the acoustic issues. Blinds for the windows will cost approximately \$600 to \$675 each and it was decided to pursue this at a later date. It was also suggested that at some point in the future to get rid of the picnic tables in this area and replace with round Pub Tables and high chairs.

SPEAKER SYSTEM – the pole for the outside speaker will be set next week with the Town's help. Tony Tondola recommended getting a culvert to install at the base of the pole to keep the water and muck from creating an issue and then fill that with gravel around the pole.

We received a nice thank you from the Junior Class for the spaghetti feed. A thank you was also received from Jake Otto for his scholarship funds.

VETERAN'S PANCAKE SUPPER – We are all set for that to take place on Sunday, November 9th. Hoping for a good turnout.

NEW BUSINESS

BEER LICENSE – Discussion was held on applying for a Class B Beer License that would be good for the entire year, versus applying for picnic license for each event. A motion was made by Steve Pflieger

and seconded by Mike Sigler to apply for this license. Motion carried. Sue Larson will pursue this issue.
